Driver & Fleet Requirements

- Valid government-issued photo ID (driver's license, CDL, or passport).
- DOT-regulated drivers must complete testing per 49 CFR Part 40 and FMCSA guidelines.
- Employers must maintain a current drug and alcohol testing policy on file.
- Post-accident and reasonable-suspicion tests require documented justification.
- Random testing program participants must be enrolled before selection can occur.
- Chain-of-custody forms must remain sealed and unaltered for results to be defensible.

What to Bring to Your Appointment

- Photo ID
- Employer authorization or DOT testing form (if applicable)
- Insurance or payment information
- List of current medications (for MRO review if needed)

Result Turnaround

Negative results are typically available the same business day. Non-negative results are sent to a certified MRO laboratory for confirmation, usually within 2-3 business days.
